Under the guidance of Mr. Mark Ulam, Director of Buildings and Grounds, the maintenance department is revamping their cleaning methods and supplies.

Some of these methods have already been in place, while others are being incorporated in the wake of recent concerns in the news, as well as CDC warnings.

The District uses a hospital grade disinfectant called GeneFect by Genesen, on a daily basis. The product is a one-step, broad spectrum disinfectant that our custodians use with a dilution system and trigger sprayer. GeneFect is used in all restrooms and high-tough surfaces, such as desks, doorknobs, and tables. It is also part of our newly adopted green cleaning program.

Extra precautions being taken include the use of a Victory Electrostatic Sprayer and Purell Professional Surface Disinfectant. The electrostatic sprayer will disperse VitalOxide, a hospital-grade disinfectant, to effectively eliminate mold, odors, norovirus, MRSA, Rotavirus, E. Coli, and much more. It is also EPA approved for colds, flus, and Coronavirus. The District has also purchased several freestanding Purell Hand Sanitizer Stations to place throughout the school.

With the help of these products, best practices, and promotion of frequent hand washing, we hope to stop the spread of infections as much as possible. We are grateful to our administration, faculty, and staff for their commitment to keeping our schools healthy and safe.
