It is a pleasure to welcome you to a new school year. Your child is entering a very important time in their academic preparation. It is the goal of the Neshannock Township School District to provide opportunity for all of our students to explore and discover new and exciting learning opportunities.

Neshannock Township School District is very pleased to offer courses that are designed with the content and rigor of college level instruction. In conjunction with three local Universities we continue to offer students the opportunity to earn full college credits for comparable freshmen level college courses. Your student has demonstrated great potential for advanced learning and is enrolled in courses that are now eligible for college credit. The "College in High School" courses have been identified and designed to meet the requirements of Seton Hill, a private university located in Greensburg, Pennsylvania, Duquesne University, and the University of Pittsburgh. All three Universities have very high academic standards and will be working closely with administration and our faculty to ensure the validity of the courses. University of Pittsburgh and Seton Hill University "College Within the High School" only offers credits to Juniors and Seniors in the identified courses. Duquesne is now offering credit to students in grades 9-12 in the identified classes.

A PowerPoint has been built and put on the school website (<u>www.NTSD.org</u>) under the guidance link. The PowerPoint provides an overview of the College in High School partnership and explains how to begin the registration process for college credits. <u>You are not required to register for the college credits to remain in the course.</u> However, once registration closes, you will not be able to register for the credits. Students are still required to take the AP Exam at the end of the year regardless of College Within the High School registration.

There is a tuition fee for any of the credits. Enclosed is the online registration form and a complete list of courses for your review. You must register for the Seton Hill class on line. Seton Hill cost is \$225.00 per course. Duquesne University course is \$329.00 and the University of Pittsburgh course is \$300.00.

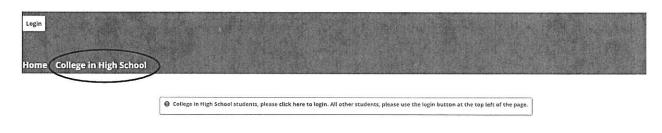
College in High School Registration Instructions FALL SEMESTER & YEAR-LONG COURSES ONLY

FOR NEW STUDENTS (never previously enrolled with CHS of Seton Hill University)

Seton Hill University and your high school are working together to offer eligible students the opportunity to earn college credits through the College in High School (CHS) Program. Register for one or more of the approved courses and upon successful completion of each course, you will receive college credit from Seton Hill University. Tuition is \$225 per course and may be paid at the time of registration.

Please note: Tuition is not refundable if the student withdraws from a course after registration closes.

1. Go to https://griffingate.setonhill.edu/ics and click on the College in High School tab.



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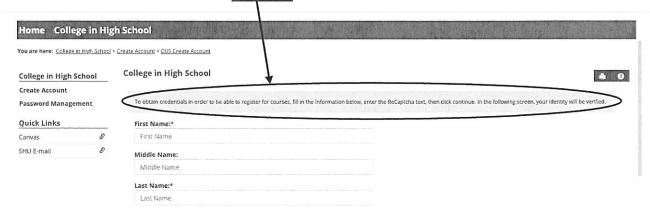
2. Click the Continue button.



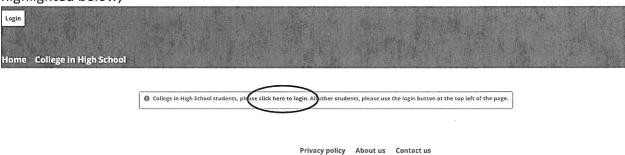
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
3. Follow the instructions in the gold box at the top of the page, then click **Continue.**



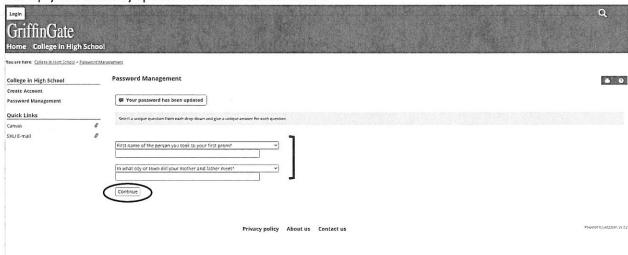
- 4. Go to the email you entered to receive your login credentials. You may have to wait up to 5 minutes before attempting to log in.
- 5. Once you have your credentials, go to https://griffingate.setonhill.edu/ics and click the link highlighted below,




6. Enter your credentials (the first item is your username which is your student ID number; the second item is your password).




7. Set up your security questions and click Continue.



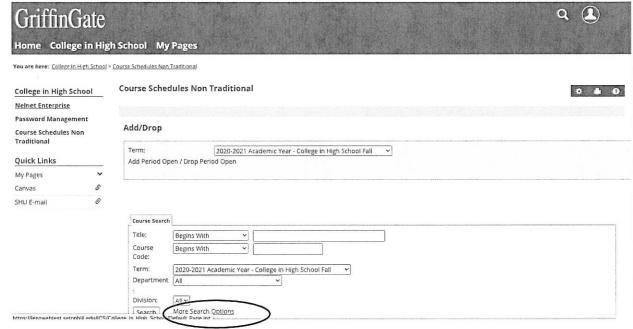
8. Click on the College in High School tab at the top of the page.



9. Go to Course Selections Non-Traditional link in the left navigation panel.

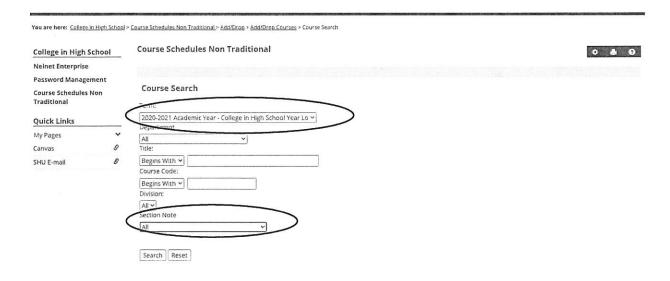


10. Then select More Search Options

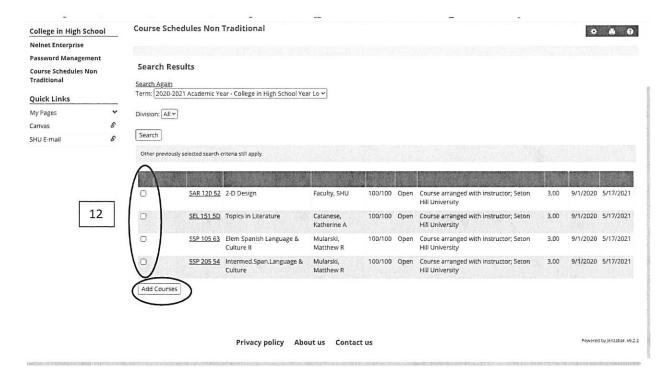


- 11. Select the correct **Term** from the dropdown list. Choices are:
