Athletics

- NCAA
 - Division 1 and 2 schools
 - Register online for pre approval at www.eligibilitycenter.org School code 392902

Looks at courses taken (core classes), GPA, and SAT/ACT scores

All have minimum eligibility requirements. Register now if you intend to continue athletics at Division 1 or 2 schools

Dual Enrollment/Independent Study/Transfer Credits etc..

- **Dual Enrollment/Transfer Credits- these are courses taken directly from the college**
 - Contact the college directly for college transcripts
 - If students are using College credits for HS credit- I MUST have a copy of the OFFICIAL transcript
 - NONE are calculated into GPA
- **College Within the High School- these are the Honors/AP classes taken at school. Students had to register at the beginning of the year for these credits.**
 - Seton Hill College, Pitt, Duquesne
 - Contact the college directly for college transcripts
