- Obtaining the specialized instruction needed to provide FAPE
- Understanding timelines and procedures for evaluations and IEP implementation
- Your options when your child's school is not following his/her IEP or 504 accommodations/goals
- Ensuring an educational placement with typical peers in the least restrictive environment (LRE)
- What to do if you disagree with an Evaluation Report or Identification
- What to do if student is transferring to a different school with an IEP
- Requesting IEP revisions
