5. Finances

A. IU IV Agreement and Sub Contracts

- 1) The Administration was authorized to enter into an IDEA Pass Thru Funds Use of Funds Agreement with IU IV for the period of July 1, 2022, thru June 30, 2023.
- 2) The Administration was authorized to enter into an IDEA-B, Section 611 sub-contract with IU IV for the implementation of the Individuals with Disability Education Act for the period July 1, 2022, through September 30, 2023.

B. Sale of Property – Lawrence County Tax Claim Bureau

The Board authorized the Administration to accept the recommendation of the Lawrence County Tax Claim Bureau for the sale of a property held in the Lawrence County Repository of Unsold Properties.

6. Board Issues

A. Lawrence County Career & Technical Center Board Member and Alternate

Following acceptance of the resignation of Patrick J. Copple as Board Member and Autumn Schachern as Alternate from their two-year terms to the Joint Operating Committee of the Lawrence County Career and Technical Center thru December 31, 2023, Kelly Corey was appointed to fill the balance of the term held by Mr. Copple and Mr. Copple was then appointed as Alternate for the same term.

B. Concurrent Enrollment Agreement – Pitt

The formal Concurrent Enrollment Agreement between the District and Pitt for their general chemistry course from August 29, 2022, thru June 7, 2023, was approved.

C. Pre-K Program

The Board authorized the continuation of the tuition-based Pre-K Program for the 2023-24 school year; and in doing so, established the tuition rate at \$6,500 per student.

D. Sharon Regional Linkage Agreement

The Linkage Agreement between Sharon Regional Hospital and the District for the Partial Hospitalization Programs Kite Strings and Pathfinders for placement of children ages 11 thru 18, as needed, was approved for the calendar year 2023.

E. Return of Authorities Levying Tax to Tax Claim Bureau

The Board authorized execution of a Return of Authorities Levying Tax to the Tax Claim Bureau for delinquent 2022 real estate taxes.
