Information for High School Students and Parents

Students from participating school districts can register for one or more of the approved Seton Hill University College in High School courses through their high school, and, upon successful completion of the course, receive college credit from Seton Hill.

Most colleges and universities accept credits from Seton Hill University. We advise high school students to contact their desired institution(s) of higher education directly to obtain the most current credit transfer policy. The credits earned through the College in High School program are posted to a Seton Hill University transcript.

College in High School FALL Course Registration

Registration for Fall courses opens on September 25, 2023, and closes on October 30, 2023.

College in High School registration is completed online.

The cost of tuition for College in High School courses is substantially less than the regular college tuition. Tuition for the 2023-2024 Academic Year is \$230 per course and may be paid online at the time of registration. If payment is NOT made at the time of registration, the student will be sent a statement of their account via email. The deadline for fall and year-long course tuition payments is November 13, 2023.
